### HOW TO PARTICIPATE IN THE STAR DRAWING?

All Painters who have met the following requirements can participate in the **STAR** Program:

1. Must be a member from:

**Local 1036** or **Local 52** or **Local 1399**

2. Must have completed the necessary safety & training requirement classes; a **minimum** of a **BRONZE** entry level to *participate*

3. Must be a current member (at least 1 year)

### GOLD: CLASS REQUIREMENTS

- 12. Floor Coating and Sealers 8hrs. or Mobile Elevating Work Platforms (MEWP's) 8hrs.
- 11. Swing Stage 8hrs. or Infection Control Risk Assessment (ICRA) 8hrs.
- 10. **BRONZE** and **SILVER** Requirements

### SILVER: Class Requirements

- 9. OSHA 10 (Certified on or after 2017)
- 8. Renovation, Repair & Paint (RRP) or Refinery Safety Overview (RSO) or 8 hour Lead Refresher
- 7. Confined Space or Globally Harmonized System (GHS)
- 6. **BRONZE** Requirements

Up to **\$30,000** in Prizes!

### BRONZE: Class Requirements

- 5. CPR
- 4. First Aid
- 3. Respirator
- 2. Fall Protection
- 1. Scaffold

Up to **\$25,000** in Prizes!

- ✓ Worked **900 hours** within **August 2021-September 2022**
- ✓ Must have completed **STAR** sponsored courses, approved by the Finishing Trades Institute (FTI)/Apprenticeship Center of DC36, during the program period (**August 2021-September 2022**)
- ✓ Online training courses are **not** accepted with the exception of OSHA 10 and OSHA 30 sponsored by FTI International
- ✓ Apprentices must be currently attending semester classes
- ✓ Members who have been found guilty at the DC36 Trial Board Hearings between August 2021 - September 2022 **CAN NOT PARTICIPATE IN THIS YEARS STAR PROGRAM**
- ✓ Full-time employees of DC36, Finishing Trades Apprenticeship Program, IUPAT, and Contract Management (including employers) **ARE NOT ELIGIBLE TO WIN**
- ✓ All rules only apply for the August 2021 through September 2022 program period
