WPCCA Legislative Report - March 2022

The bill introduction period for the 2022 session of the California State legislature concluded on February 18th. Since that time, we have sifted through the 2000 plus legislative proposals introduced this year to ensure we are actively involved with all that may affect WPCCA members.

It is noteworthy to mention that WPCCA's position on certain legislative issues have changed.

 AB 2454 (Jones-Sawyer) Public contracts: Protests: Joint Labor-Management Committee: This bill would additionally authorize a joint labor-management committee, as defined, to submit a specified protest to a contract that is not to be awarded to the lowest bidder - *Position: Pending -> Active*
